

First Peoples Principles Of Learning:

Grade 2

Math

FPPL + Capable Person Connection:

In the Trading on the Land Market activity, students learn through hands-on, experiential trading, reflecting FPPL's emphasis on holistic and relational learning.

This supports the Capable Person framework by building relationships with others (sharing, trading) and the land (understanding resources), while developing responsibility and decision-making.

Science

FPPL + Capable Person Connection:

In the Water on the Land activity, students observe and reflect on water in their environment, aligning with FPPL's focus on learning from the land and recognizing responsibility to it. This connects to the Capable Person framework by strengthening relationships with the land and spiritual values, encouraging respect, care, and reflection.

English

FPPL + Capable Person Connection:

In the Build Your Capable Tipi activity, students share personal ideas and experiences, reflecting FPPL's emphasis on storytelling, identity, and connection to community. This supports the Capable Person framework by building relationships with self (identity) and others (listening and sharing), and promoting self-awareness.

Social studies

FPPL + Capable Person Connection:

In the Caring for Our Community activity, students explore how their actions affect others and the environment, aligning with FPPL's focus on understanding consequences and connections to place. This supports the Capable Person framework by strengthening relationships with others and the land, and encouraging responsibility and reciprocity.
